Library Report:

- Substantial new technology has been installed in the Library. There are 50-VDI units installed for use in the Library (Virtual Desktop Infrastructure). By the end of the Spring semester, close to 100 VDI systems will be installed in the Library. The student reaction has been positive. Throughout the college there are close to 600 VDI systems installed.
- On April 10th 9a-2pm. Library systems will be unavailable due to migrate the services to a more secure network. The work will be performed during Spring Break and the impact should be low to students.
- The Library 24-hour access upcoming final exam period: May 13th-25th.
- The Library has been working with The College Health and Wellness Programs to deliver three exercise bikes to the Library. The bikes are intended to give patrons a chance to take a study break and get some exercise.
