A quorum was not present. All votes taken were unanimous.

1. The committee approved the minutes of November 13, 2013.
2. The committee approved proposals from the Department of Middle and High School Education to create an experimental course, ESC 4530 and a new course, ESC 4900, the first subject to revisions.
3. Proposals from the Department of Middle and High School Education to change college wide and major GPA requirements in the Admission Requirements of Undergraduate Secondary Teacher Education (Art, English, Foreign language, Health Mathematics Science,), the Certification Sequence of Undergraduate Secondary Teacher Education (Art, English, Foreign language, Health Mathematics Science) and the Admission Requirement of Undergraduate Teacher Education in Social Studies were sent back to the Dept. Other changes in these proposals were approved.
4. The committee approved proposals from the Department of Chemistry to change the prerequisites of CHE $166,168,342$ and 344 , to withdraw courses CHE 104,105,106 and 327 and to create new courses, CHE 242 and 243 , the last pending revisions.
5. The committee approved proposals from the Department of Chemistry to change the degree requirements of the 81 credit major in Chemistry, B.S. with a Specialization in Biochemistry.
6. Proposals from the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science to change the course description and number of credits of CIS 166 and CMP 405 , and the course descriptions, number of credits and course numbers of CMP 230 and 326 were approved, all except CMP 405 pending revisions.
7. Proposals from the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science to change the 58 credit Major in Computer Graphics, B.S., the 56-58 credit Major in Computer Information Systems, B.S., the 43-44 credit Major in Computers Science, B.A., the 56-60 credit major in Computer Science, B.S., and the 40-44 credit Major in Mathematics, B.A., were approved, subject to minor editing.
8. The committee approved a proposal from the Department of Earth, Environmental and Geospatial Sciences to change the degree requirements of the Certificate in Earth Sciences.
9. The UCC will hold its next meeting in the 2014 New Year on February 5 at 1:00 in CA 263.
