Draft minutes the April 17, 2013 Meeting of Lehman College Joint Committee of Senate and FP&B Long-Range Plan and Budget*

The meeting was called to order at 3:35 pm by Chair Haiping Cheng in room S- 336. The Minutes for the Feb. 27, 2013 meeting was approved.

Lehman financial report (the draft third quarter report) was presented by VP Clark with the following highlights

- -Energy consumption was lower than project. The small saving will be applied towards future energy needs.
- -OTPS has decreased slightly
- -Projected Adjunct budget has increased slightly
- -Hiring in non-academic areas is not projected to impact the budget.
- -Current projected yearend balance is \$0.49 M in addition to the 0.775 M saving

A report on the FY 2012-2013 Compact Investment was also presented by VP Clark. The compact funding was spent on following three areas

- -Mandated by the State (\$1.4 M): full time faculty, textbook, tuition waivers, and workstudy.
- -Priority items (determined by the college): the new Dean for School of Health, etc.
- -Priority items determined by each of the divisions.

Report by Provost Morrobel-Sosa on the current plan to increase quality of teaching.

- 3 year plans have been developed and evaluated at Department, School, and College levels based on long-term strategic plans.
- Review current practices and invest more to improve teaching
- -Strength research through education including inviting federal funding agencies to visit Lehman, and funding travel grants to support faculty research efforts.

Other major issues discussed

-The effects of early closing of OTPS purchasing on teaching science labs due to difficulties of predicting when to order replacements.

The committee adjourned at 4:50 PM.
