A quorum was present. All votes taken were unanimous.

1. The minutes of the meetings of February 25, 2009 were approved.
2. A proposal from the Steering Committee of the Urban Studies Program to create a new minor in Urban Community Development was approved, pending minor editing.
3. Proposals from the Department of African and African American Studies to change the course descriptions and prerequisites of AAS 226 and AAS 316 were approved, subject to minor editing.
4. Proposals from the Department of Middle and High School Education to create new and experimental courses, ESC 475, were approved.
5. A proposal from the Department of Latin American and Puerto Rican Studies to create a new course, LAC 238 was approved, pending minor editing.
6. The committee approved a proposal from the Department of Political Science to create a new course, POL 314, pending minor editing.
7. A proposal from the Department of Journalism, Communication and Theatre to create a new course, THE 325, was sent back to the Department for clarification.
8. Proposals from the Interdisciplinary Program in Linguistics to create new courses LNG 337 and LNG 340 were approved.
9. A proposal from the Department of African and African American Studies and the Interdisciplinary Program in Linguistics to change the cross listing of AAS 339 was approved.
10. A proposal from the Department of Latin American and Puerto Rican Studies to create a new minor in Mexican and Mexican American Studies was approved, pending editing and revisions.
11. Proposals from the Department of Latin American and Puerto Rican Studies to create

new courses LAC 364, LAC 268, SPA(LAC) 346 and LAC 363 were approved, pending minor editing.

12. A proposal from the Department of Art to change the description of ART 328 was sent back to the Department.

13. Proposals from the Department of Art to change the course description and prerequisites of ART 308 and the course description of ART 108 were approved, subject to minor editing.
