- 2. Proposals from the Dept. of English to pull the withdrawal of ENG 324, to change the title description, credits and prerequisite of ENG 303 and to change the prerequisites of ENW 301, ENW 302 and ENW(THE) 308 were approved.
- 3. The committee approved a proposal from Macauley College to change the hours and credits of MHC 355.
- 4. Proposals from the Dept. of History to create new courses HIS 328, HIS 329 and HIW(AAS) 323 were approved, subject to minor editing.
- 5. Proposals from the Dept. of History to change the course number of HIW 323 was approved.
- 6. A proposal from the Dept. Anthropology to change the title and course description of ANT 324 was approved, pending minor editing.
- 7. A proposal from the Dept. of Middle and High School Education to change the Undergraduate Program Requirements for Teacher Education Programs was approved, subject to revisions.
- 8. The next meeting will be held in on Feb. 16. It will consist of a hearing on the BOT's resolution to reduce Lehman's lower division General Education requirements to a maximum of 36 credits. Both the problems that the BOT has identified as the reasons for this change as well as the resolution itself will be discussed.
