The committee discussed the new procedures for submissions of courses and approved the following motion: Departments should simultaneously submit their proposals to the Provost's and the relevant Deans' offices. Upon submission, the Provost's office should circulate proposals to the college and the Undergraduate Curriculum Committee.
- 3. The committee approved proposals from the Department of Art to create a new and an experimental course, ART 355.
- 4. Proposals from the Department of Environmental, Geographic and Geological Sciences to a create new and am experimental course, GEP 321, were approved, pending minor editing.
- 5. A proposal from the Department of English to change the degree requirements for the English/ECCE concentration was approved.
- 6. A proposal from the Department of Health Sciences to create a new course, DFN 342, was approved, pending minor editing.
- 7. A proposal from the Dept. of Journalism, Communication and Theatre to create a new minor in Theatre Management was approved, subject to minor editing.
- 8. The committee approved a proposal from the Department of Languages and Literatures to create an experimental course, IRI 381, subject to editorial changes.
- 9. Proposals from the Department of Philosophy to change the prerequisite of PHI 230 and create a new course, DST(PHI) 336, were approved, subject to revisions.
- 10. The next meeting will be held when warranted by sufficient data items.
