



Introduction

The Lehman College Now 2025 Summer Academy will provide high school students with a unique opportunity to enroll in a college credit course that will meet in person on the Lehman College campus. Students apply for only <u>one</u> of the course programs listed below. The program is FREE for eligible students and College Now covers the cost of tuition and transportation (Metro Cards).

Eligibility (PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE APPLYING)

- Student must be a NYC Public HS student entering 10th, 11th or 12th grade in fall 2025. HS 10th graders are <u>only eligible to</u> <u>apply for DNC or THE courses.</u> HS 11th and 12th graders may apply for any one of the programs below.
- 2. Students must have an overall HS Average of 80+.
- **3.** ENG 111: Student must have an overall average of 80+ AND 75+ on ELA Regents Exam.
- 4. MAT 126: Student must have overall HS average of 80+ and 70+ on Algebra I Regents exam.
- 5. MAT 172/MAT 108: Student must have overall HS average of 80+ AND successfully completed Algebra II course with an 80+ average AND 70+ on Algebra I Regents exam.

Program Schedule

The Lehman College Now 2025 Summer Academy will meet on the Lehman College campus on a Monday through Thursday schedule from Monday June 30 through Thursday July 31. The DNC and THE courses will end on August 4 & 5 with a Dance and Theatre Performance at the Lovinger Theatre. There will be a <u>mandatory orientation</u> on campus on Thursday June 26 for all accepted students. Classes will meet in person according to the following schedule:
