WOMEN WITH LONG WORK HOURS AND DIABETES MANAGEMENT

In the United States (U.S.), labor is often stratified by sex and this form of occupational segregation can contribute to health disparities. Certain work schedule characteristics, such as long work hours, can prevent proper management of chronic health conditions, including diabetes. In the present study, Professor Gonzalez examined the association between work hours and suboptimal diabetes management among U.S. workers, testing for differences by sex. She will present novel findings specific to women workers, highlighting the importance of examining how and for whom work conditions hinder or support health.
