The Department of Languages and Literature offers a master's degree program designed for individuals interested in the literature of Spain and Latin America, and/or who plan to enter doctoral programs.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- Official transcripts from **all** post-secondary institutions attended
 - Have attained a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university
 - Have completed 18 credits in advanced (300 level and above) undergraduate Spanish courses
 - A minimum of 9 advanced credits in literature courses conducted in Spanish
 - Have attained a minimum undergraduate grade point average of 3.0
- Two letters of recommendation
- Current professional resume
- A 500-word essay outlining intellectual and academic interests, accomplishments, and career objectives
- An academic writing sample in Spanish
- If conditionally admitted, make up not more than 12 credits of specified undergraduate course work, starting in the first semester and finishing in no more than three consecutive semesters
- Report to the department for consultation with the advisor and assessment of Spanish language skills prior to matriculation

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

- Completion of 30 approved graduate credits of study in Spanish Literature:
 - A minimum of one course in Peninsular literature (3 credits)
 - A minimum of one course in Latin American literature (3 credits)
 - 5 elective Graduate Spanish courses (15 credits)
