Additional Information: Please describe any assessment-related changes and the impacts of those changes that have taken place since the most recent Program Review:

During an assessment, it was found that student achievement on some of the Department's program goals were uneven because some assignments did not require students to do the tasks. As a result, the Department discussed that, to ensure that students are able to achieve some of their program objectives or goals, such as Option A, Goal 1A, and Option B, Goal 1A, which ask students to explain a philosophical position or ethical theory as well as an alternative position or ethical theory, the department needs to be sure that instructors construct assignments that require students to complete these tasks. There was agreement that some assignments in both tracks (cf. Action 9) should require this of students so that can achieve this goal by the end of their degree program (Assessment, Spring 2023).
