- Link curriculum maps to student learning outcomes





What are Curriculum Maps?

Curriculum Maps are a visual, term-by-term representation of the paths students can take toward a successful and timely completion of their chosen course of study.

Curriculum maps are used as guides, and they should be used in conjunction with student advising, the online bulletin, and degree audits from DegreeWorks.

Curriculum maps can and should play a key role in proactive course scheduling and planning for academic departments.







Graduates by Cohort
