The Milman Scholarship provides opportunities ""

for undergraduate and graduate candidates* in educator preparation programs to explore innovative ideas and strategies in learning how to effectively teach students in high-needs schools through the integration of arts.

Each award recipient will be expected to:

- create a project that represents the integration of the arts into a particular area of study. The project will focus on supporting K-12 students and future leaders in developing knowledge and skills through the use of music, dance, drama, visual arts or another art medium.
- by the end of the award semester, the recipient will present the artifact in a relevant course and share it with a professional organization as a resource to be disseminated to other educational professionals.
- The Milman Scholar will make the presentation available as a resource for other candidates and teachers in different settings (e.g., a presentation at the SOE LUTE Reception, a framed display/video of the artifact in the SOE; or as a teacher resource on the MHSE website).
