Endowed Chair Professor of Sociology University of California Santa Barbara

This talk explores how interactions break down and why people sometimes struggle to understand each other. Using video and audio recordings from my ethnographic research, Dr. Duck highlights (1) interactions cases: shaped three neighborhood poverty, divestment and the drug food insecurity and neighborhood trade, (2) solidarity, and (3) a clinic where children are assessed for autism, focusing on a test that measures emotional understandings in verbally fluent children. Through these examples, Dr. Duck reveals the hidden social rules and expectations that guide everyday interactions, rules we often take for granted until they break down.
